### **'OHE KĀPALA WORKSHOP - HAWAIIAN BAMBOO STAMP CLASSES**

Participants will learn how to prepare an 'ohe kāpala from the raw material and begin to carve one with a design. Participant will also have a chance to stamp with actual bamboo stamps that have been already carved to experience. Taught by the high school students of Māhu'ilani, the Cultural Arts Program of Ke Kula 'O Nāwah'okalani'ōpu'u, the Hawaiian Medium Education School in Kea'au, Puna, Hawai'i. Classes taught in Hawaiian and English language.

Supplies provided - 2 bamboo pieces – 1 raw, 1 ready to carve

### **MOKULEHUA WORKSHOP - KALA'I AIONA**

All workshops incorporate use of natural materials and resources from plants grown in Hawai'i. They were raised and prepared to create native handcrafts that will be taught through a mixture of English and Hawaiian.

Wed - Lei Lā'i - ti-leaf lei

Thurs - Pūlumi Ni'au & Apolima Niu- Coconut midrib broom & weaved coconut bracelet

Fri - Apu Niu - Coconut shell cup

Sat - Oeoe & Apolima Hau - Hau Hawaiian Whistle with Kamani Nut & Hau bracelet

No pre-registration, workshops daily from 12pm to 2pm.

### **KAPA WORKSHOP - DALANI TANAHY**

Learn about Hawaiian kapa print and design using ohe kapala. Print your own canvas bag. Hawaiian kapa practitioner, Dalani Tanahy will explain about Hawaiian thought and influence in this particular style of design as well as types and process of natural dyes.
